Yes, it's that time again. Time to vote on the Fan Activity Achievement awards. Time for the administrator to beg, plead, cajole, threaten, apologise, pout, and eventually slump into an exhausted heap and pretend not to hear any future requests to take charge of the awards again.

'Would it save you a lot of time if I just gave up and went mad now?'

Go on, prove me wrong. Cast your ballots now. Don't forget. Don't decide it doesn't matter. Don't wait until the very last minute. Think how smug you'd be feeling now if you'd voted before you even saw this PR.

I'm not asking you to end world hunger or war, or to get everyone to agree about climate change. I'm not even asking you to produce a fanzine, or create a cover, or write a letter of comment. I'm just encouraging you to vote on the FAAn awards, and to do so in sufficient numbers that the people who win feel happy for a little while longer.

You're reading a progress report for Corflu, which must mean you're interested in fanzines or else that you've got very, very lost in the internet. You might even be planning to attend the convention. Are you really so disconnected from a fandom you'd spend money to go and hang out with in a plush hotel that you aren't motivated to express your views on whose fanzine activity you enjoyed last year?

Two weeks before today's deadline, 49 of the people listed on the Corflu membership list had not yet voted. And neither had considerably more than 49 other people who might count themselves as interested in SF fanzines. If you're not a member of Corflu, but you're interested in fanzines, don't think you're off the hook. You can still vote. Why let people who are going to Corflu have all the fun?

But before this, there are five things you need to be aware of:

1. Vote for the 2015 FAAn Awards. Ballots and more details are available at www.corflu.org and must be completed and returned by midnight April 23rd to be counted. You do not have to be a member of Corflu to vote. It is open to anyone who knows how to spell the word fanzine and cares enough to share their opinions about such topics. You can even be picky about which categories to actually vote for. Don't delay.
2. A special publication is planned for all members of Corflu 33. Please take a few minutes to share your favourite Corflu memories, photos, third-hand stories, etc. Send all submissions to this email address as quickly as possible because time is also running out for this opportunity.
3. Are you planning on driving to Chicago? If you are, please let me know, so suitable arrangements can be made for inexpensive parking during the convention weekend. Like many older hotels, there is no hotel parking available, and unless using expensive valet parking is your style, I need to know how many spaces to reserve. Send me your expected arrival and departures times as well.
4. There will be a Fan Fund/Corflu 50/Corflu auction of fannish memorabilia. Many fun and rare items have been promised, but if you also have items to sell/donate, please send a description ahead of time so they can be properly promoted to all interested parties. Remote bidding will be accommodated, but all bidders in the auction will need to be a paid member of Corflu 33, or have donated auction items.
5. There will be t-shirts. Full details in PR2.

Remember, act on all or some of these items today or tomorrow to avoid disappointment later.

Hello,

This is just a quick interim progress report to remind everyone of the upcoming release of the Corflu hotel room block. You need to have a confirmed hotel reservation by April 1st, in order to secure rooms at our preferred rates.

To make a room reservation at the Club Quarters, Central Chicago Loop Hotel location, please use this link:

Note there should be no spaces/line breaks when copying and pasting the link.

At the hotel site you will need to select the dates of the con (May 13-15th) to see the correct rates quoted, these are \$167 and \$182 respectively. Only two room types should be shown. If additional room nights are required, adjust your reservation accordingly, however the hotel doesn't guarantee the Corflu room rate will be available for additional nights.

There is an additional \$18 a night charge for another person to stay in the room. As this is a business-oriented hotel, this charge covers all the complimentary services that the hotel offers (free wi-fi, unrestricted use of business lounge, printers, etc. and a club lounge with complimentary drinks and snacks.)

All rooms are setup with a Queen bed as standard, but if two people are sharing a twin arrangement should be requested at the time of booking and confirmed with the hotel. Some suites are available at a higher rate, these come with an additional sofa bed.

Currently there are 48 members of Corflu 33, including 9 supporters.

PR 2 should be available in a few weeks and will contain other information about Corflu activities, Chicago attractions, travel details and more.
