Authenticator Named for Trivia Challenge

“Who is was the Authenticator for the Corflu Glitter Trivia Open?” may end up as a question on some future fannish trivia quiz, but the answer is headline fan news this week. Quiz Master Sandra Bond hap tapped eminent fanhistorical Rob Hansen for the key post of authenticator for the two sets of 20 questions that will be used in the Corflu Glitter Trivia Open.

Rob Hansen has authored many fanhistory articles, including *Then*, the most detailed account ever written about British Fandom.

The Corflu Glitter Trivia Open consists of two separate competitions, one for fans at Corflu and the other for fans all over the world. The questionnaires will be distributed at the start of programming on Saturday and collected by the dinner break later in the day. The highest scorers in each contest will be proclaimed Corflu Glitter Kings (or Queens) of Trivia.

We hope to produce an after-contest fanzine with the questions and detailed answers. It will be free to Corflu Glitter members.

The voting form comes as a PDF, though a Microsoft Word version is also available on request from me (Arnie). All *Glitter* readers will receive a ballot during the first week or the New Year.

The 2012 FAAn Awards salute excellence in fan writing, drawing, publishing and posting during 2011. The ballot has seven categories: Best Gzine, Best Personalzine, Best Single Issue or Special Publication, Best Fan Website, Best Fanwriter, Best Fanartist/Cartoonist and the Harry Warner Memorial Award for Best Letterhack. The total points leader will be designated #1 Fan Face.

First-place finishers in each category will be announced at the Corflu Glitter banquet and will receive framed certificates, designed by Brad Foster, to commemorate the achievement.
