In-N-Out Burger began as a humble hamburger stand in Baldwin Park, California, in 1948. This is *the* burger. I still get a double-double, but I often order animal style with onions grilled in mustard (*see the Not So Secret Menu.*)

In-N-Out serves 100% pure beef burgers, fries, sodas and shakes. You can order your burger with up to four patties (4x4). Each burger comes with hand-leafed lettuce, tomato, onion, pickle and sauce. The shakes are very good, and you can order as half n' half: strawberry vanilla, vanilla chocolate, or chocolate strawberry. The fries are fresh cut on site from real potatoes. They also can be ordered animal style, topped with mustard-grilled onions and covered in sauce. Animal-style fries are so secret, they aren't on the Not So Secret Menu. (BD)
