At the table, turn your marker card to green for the main course, and the passadões bring flame-roasted cuts of beef, pork, lamb, chicken and Brazilian sausage, still on the sword skewers, to your table. Fried plantains, mashed potatoes and Brazilian cheese bread are sides. Flip the card to red when you've had enough. Save room for dessert! Key Lime Pie or Brazilian Papaya Cream? At the bar, try their signature Brazilian. (BD)
